

These vines, shaped by the intense Alpine climate and dramatic day-night temperature shifts, absorb the purest essence of Valtellina's rugged landscape, yielding wines of extraordinary elegance and depth. DESCRIPTION

Surrounded by the Alps on three sides, Piedmont enjoys natural protection that creates a continental climate with significant temperature variations. Autumn is marked by the region's characteristic fog, which blankets the hills and contributes to a unique microclimate. The terrain is predominantly hilly, with diverse soils ranging from calcareous marl to sandy and clay-rich formations, offering an extraordinary geological variety.

Crafted with artisanal care and aged for a long time, Poggio Ezio's Timorasso evolves over the years, revealing surprising aromatic complexity and a structure almost reminiscent of a red wine.

DESCRIPTION

Tuscany's defining feature is its gently rolling hills, covering 80% of the region. These elevations ensure perfect sun exposure and natural ventilation. The Mediterranean climate, milder along the coast and more continental inland, provides ideal temperature variations. The soil, rich in clay, sand, and rocky formations like galestro and alberese, enhances the diversity of agricultural production.



DESCRIPTION

This region stands out for its high-altitude vineyards, ranging from 200 to 1,000 meters above sea level. The Alpine and continental climate is influenced by the wind, which keeps the air dry and creates strong temperature fluctuations between day and night. The Dolomites shield the region from cold currents, while volcanic, calcareous, and moraine-rich soils provide an ideal environment for high-quality cultivation.

The vineyards, clinging to steep slopes, require heroic cultivation, where each grape cluster is meticulously cared for. The vineyards, kissed by the sun during the day and caressed by the cool night air, yield wines of extraordinary depth an authenticity that only the mountains can provide.

Lake Garda helps moderate temperatures, creating a particularly favorable microclimate in the surrounding areas. The soils vary from volcanic formations in the hills to alluvial deposits in the lower plains.
